Board Meeting

December 27, 2007

President Dave Keiser WB9UNL called the meeting to order at 7:06 P.M. Board Members present were: Dave Keiser WB9UNL, Richard Leo W9EEE, Dan Dahms N9WNH, John Butcher KC9FBA, Herman Smith Jr. WB9SPY, Lanny Kelly K9OOP and Roger McEntarfer N9QCL.

Club members present were: Melanie Dahms KC9MJT, Homer Crowder N9HRC, Don Evilsizor KA9QWC and Cathy Evilsizor WB8ORR.

Secretary Dan N9WNH read the minutes of the last Board Meeting, with one correction noted. Concerning Health & Welfare information regarding Judy Mackey xyl of Henry N9HM returning to Minneapolis for further treatments. It should read Minnesota specifically Rochester. No further corrections noted there for the minutes were approved as corrected.

Dan N9WNH passed around a copy of the letter from the WCARC Executive Session on November 29th for the Officers to sign for record keeping purposes.

Treasurer John Butcher KC9FBA read the financial report for the club. John mentioned that he had contacted Cathy Broxon-Ball regarding reimbursement issues for some of the 2007 year Electric invoices. John noted that the check for Charlotte Willson spouse of Glenn Willson N9KXL SK had be given to here by Dan and Melanie Dahms for the amount of items so far sold at the Auction and Hamfest table. The report was approved pending audit.

Health & Welfare Committee:

Melanie KC9MJT gave a report of recent events as of late. A card was sent to Judy Mackey regarding her recent hospital stay in Rochester, Minn. Also her sister had passed away recently and the club sent a card to them regarding this also. Henry N9HM and Judy have had a lot of issues to go through and her treatments are on-going for now, we wish them the best.

Don KA9QWC was asked about the status of Howard N9ICA and he asked that Dan N9WNH give that report as he was more familiar with it. Dan stated that he had talked to Howard over the phone for close to an hour the other day. Howard has had three strokes and has had diabetes for some time. He is and has been unable to work any longer and has been back at home for close to a year now after being a resident in a North Manchester nursing home. He finally has received disability status and has been improving in speech and motor skills. He is basically confined to a wheelchair most of the time but is able to walk a little with assistance.

Howard would like some help in retrieving his items from the Markle area and from his mother's house on 1000S. He also would like to put up his antennas at his home in South Whitley come spring. Dan said he would get with Howard soon to get him back on the air at least VHF/UHF on his H.T.'s as soon as Howard gets them dugout. Dan asked that we find some time to assist him in whatever and whenever we can. Dan also said that Howard would probably enjoy some company or at least a phone call.

Dan N9WNH also mentioned that he called Lewis W9SMQ about the Dinner Meeting and offered him transportation but Lewis was not feeling up to it. He thought that we should all pay Lewis a visit some time soon also.

Repeater/Station Committee:

President Dave Keiser asked if there was any new information to be shared. Dan N9WNH stated that he had emailed Jack Moore of Embarq inquiring if there had been any new developments. But he received an automatic return email stating that he was on vacation until after the first of the year.

Dan N9WNH stated the 440 Repeater had acted up a few times and he had Don KA9QWC or Melanie KC9MJT give him a weak signal tests with H.T.'s out 4-5 miles from the repeater on various power settings. Things seem to be ok once he tightened up some slightly loose connectors on the transmit, receive and duplexer ports. He had readjusted the squelch setting because it appeared that it would be fine. But the cold weather seems to have its effects on the radios. He had to disable the receiver remotely a couple of times when he was mobile on his way out of the county until he could return to the site for readjustment.

He also said the power supply had quit and had to be replaced with one of the club's 20A Astron's. He is checking into the power supply again since it was the one that was taken out by a surge or lightning strike before. He also questioned if the site had experienced some voltage surges from power losses in town over the last month. Voltage checks good from inside the cabinet. Lanny K9OOP said he has better signal into and out of the repeater now from Ligonier.

Dan said he had checked into possibly getting assistance from CCFD with there Ladder Truck but forgot that the truck's reach is only 75' which does not do us much good in removing the Comet GP-9N Dual Band Antenna, the 150' of ½ heliax and the two bottom mounts from the tower. The lowest mount is the only thing it could reach. It might be in our best interest to wait and when we can move the 440 Repeater to also remove its heliax and the DB408 Antenna from the top all at the same time using a tower climber.

Board Meeting Chairman Handoff:

President Dave Keiser then turned the meeting over to the 2008 President Dan N9WNH. Dan N9WNH thanked Dave and the 2007 Board for there commitment this past year and also thanked those that are serving for the 2008 year. He said he would cover some of the Old Business topics first and then cover a few things for the upcoming year that he felt he was prepared to discuss.

Old Business:

Glenn Willson Remaining Estate Equipment:

Dan N9WNH explained that when he and Melanie KC9MJT had delivered the check to Charlotte Willson that she offered to give the WCARC the remaining items that had not been sold yet and we could keep or dispense with as we see fit. Dan told Charlotte that he would have to bring this back to the Board and the Committee for them to discuss.

Dan asked how the members felt about accepting Charlotte's offer? All felt comfortable with it. Richard W9EEE made a motion to accept the offer at this point and once we decide what the club wants to keep, we dispose of the other items with possibly the idea of the funds going to the H&W Fund. Seconded by John KC9FBA. Motion carried.

Dan suggested we analyze the finances of the club before we commit everything to a specific fund, drawing up a budget with line items for each area if possible as we have some expenses in the upcoming year and we also need to consider upgrading or replacing some station equipment which maybe covered by grants or fundraisers instead.

February 14th General Meeting:

Dan N9WNH advised the Board that the February meeting could not be held at the Peabody Library as they were using the meeting room for the Book Fair. He has scheduled the South Whitley Public Library meeting room in the lower level for that meeting with the program yet to be announced. We will be taking the club "on the road" per say and he said he was also considering to have a meeting at the Churubusco Library sometime this year if the facilities and the Library hours could work etc.

New Business:

Board Meeting Time Change:

Dan N9WNH asked what the consensus of the 2008 Board Members present if they mind meeting at 7 P.M. instead of 7:30 P.M. to realign the meeting times again for both the General and Board Meetings. Most were ok with this as it was changed in the past to accommodate a few who are no longer serving on the board when they had other activities that delayed them. Dan said the meeting room and the club printed schedule shows us meeting at 7 P.M. but he will check with Becky N9RJB and Ewing K9RWO before making this official at the next meeting.

Officer Changes for Club Bank Account:

John KC9FBA asked when the 2008 Officers would be willing to meet to change over the Star Financial Bank account signatures and information. He asked if we could do it this Saturday at 9 A.M. at the Frontage Rd. Branch? All those present agreed that would be the best.

Peabody Library Assistance:

Dan N9WNH suggested we talk to the Peabody Library about assisting them periodically as a group with volunteers. He felt we need to let them know we appreciate letting us meet here and that we need to do something show it as good users. It was suggested we could donate books we may have at home that we do not want that could be sold at the Book Fair. Also we could assist them with physical help at the Book Fair also. Don KA9QWC mentioned that he does volunteer as an individual and is assigned an area in the Library to re-shelve books etc. Dan will contact them to see what we can do. Also do not forget we should be planning the program that was asked for in 2007 for school kids about amateur radio!

2008 Committee Appointments:

Dan N9WNH mentioned that he is working on Committee assignments for the upcoming year. We will have the standing Committees as in the past but we will also have some new ones to reflect what we normally deal with on a regular basis.

Dan asked for volunteers for the 2008 Year. So far this is what we have.

January Club Program:

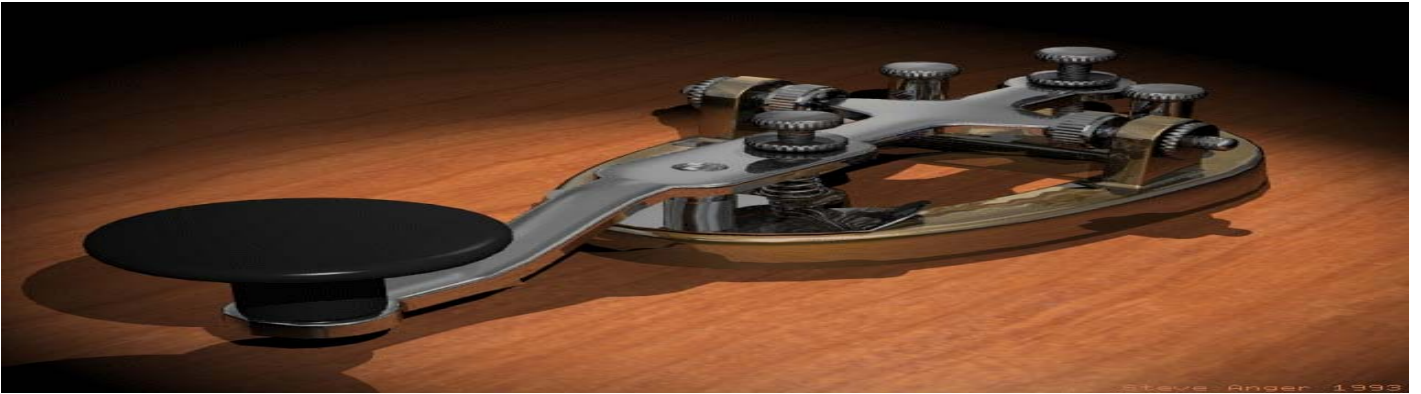
